An Oregon jury found that BP West Coast Products LLC (“BPWCP”) charged more for gas than the amount registered at the pump and failed to properly disclose its prices when it charged a 35-cent fee to consumers who used debit cards to pay for gas at Oregon ARCO-branded stations between January 1, 2011 and August 30, 2013.

Records show you purchased gas at an ARCO gas station or ARCO *ampm* mini-mart using your debit card during this time, and you could get one payment of up to \$200, minus applicable attorneys’ fees and expenses of up to \$40 per claim. If you want to receive this payment, you do not need to do anything. If you do not do anything, you will give up your right to file an individual lawsuit against BPWCP about the issues in this class action lawsuit.

BPWCP denies the claims in this case, disputes many of the rulings made in this matter, and plans to appeal the jury’s decision. No claims payments will be made unless and until the appeal has been resolved in favor of consumers in this case.

If you do not want to receive money from this lawsuit and want to keep your right to sue BPWCP, you must complete an opt-out form online or by mail or submit a letter stating that you wish to exclude yourself from this lawsuit. Opt-out forms are available at www.DebitCardClassAction.com or by calling 1-866-329-5931. All opt-out requests must be received by **January 23, 2015**.

Only complete an opt-out form if you do NOT want to receive a payment.

You also have the right to comment on or object to the request for attorneys’ fees and expenses by the attorneys representing you in this case, the handling of your claim, or the claims and notice processes used in this case. The attorneys representing Class Members indicated that they may request attorneys’ fees of up to \$40 from each Class Member’s claim for their work in this case. They will also seek reimbursement of total costs of no more than \$345,714.15. Class Counsel will ask the Court to have BPWCP pay all or some of the fees and costs. A copy of the fee petition will be available when filed (currently due on January 5, 2015) at www.DebitCardClassAction.com. All comments and objections to the handling of your claim or the claims and notice process must be received by **January 29, 2015**. All comments and objections to the request for attorneys’ fees and expenses must be received by **January 29, 2015** and will be heard at a hearing scheduled for **February 11, 2015**.
